Justyn Terry, Academic Dean at Wycliffe Hall, previously served as Dean/President of Trinity School for Ministry, Pittsburgh, USA, where he was also Professor of Systematic Theology. Before moving to the United States, Justyn was Curate of St John's Hyde Park, and Vicar of St Helen's, North Kensington, after a few years as a Physics teacher and then International Marketing Manager in the Electronics Industry.

His academic interests are in the areas of the doctrine of atonement and of Anglican theology, especially as it applies to ministerial practice.
