Resolution B012

The canons of the church around marriage place the authority of whom is married in the presbyter who is approached to officiate at the sacrament. The presbyter has full authority to decide whether he/she will/won't preside at the sacrament.

This only changes when there have been previous marriage(s). In the case of previous marriages by one or both persons wishing to be married, the consent by a bishop is required.
