Tier I Partially Subsidized. This is our historically SUBSIDIZED rate made possible through the mission funding dollars we receive from individual donors and churches who value the impact that Camp Weed has on children, youth, individuals, and families. This rate makes the experience available to more families.

Tier II Direct Cost. This represents the DIRECT cost of camp. Direct costs include program costs, food, staff, and camp administration costs.

Tier III True Cost. This rate more closely accounts for the TRUE costs of running the program. True costs include all direct costs plus deferred maintenance, insurance, utilities, etc. Choosing Tier III gives you are opportunity to help us do more with the donor funding we receive.
