

Charter and Canons
Resolution 2026-15
Adjusting the Threshold for Canonical Revision
(A Red Resolution)

Whereas a proposed canonical revision at the 182nd convention passed a majority vote and the convention understood this to be sufficient until the parliamentarian informed us otherwise and;

Whereas the decision to amend the canons belongs to the convention and convention can change the necessary threshold for amendment and;

Whereas supermajority votes are typically reserved for foundational documents like Constitutions, or in our case, Articles of Reincorporation therefore;

Be it resolved that 2025 Florida Canon 31 be amended as follows:

CANON 31

Of Alterations

SECTION 1. In General. No proposed alteration of, or addition to, these Canons shall be considered by the Diocesan Convention unless:

- (a) such alteration or addition shall have been referred to, and a recommendation made to the Convention by, the Convention Committee on Charter and Canons; or,
- (b) by unanimous consent of the Convention.

Such alterations or additions to the Canons may be adopted by a ~~two-thirds~~ majority vote of the same Convention.

SECTION 2. Additions. Additions to these Canons shall be numbered to precede this Canon.
